

STEP 1: Our scholarship landing page details eligibility criteria before starting the process of applying.



About the Scholarship:

The Worthington Scholarship Foundation awards scholarships annually to recent Maine graduates of our partner high schools who plan to attend full-time at our partner colleges.

Scholarships are awarded based on merit and financial need and are renewable up to eight (8) semesters. Award amounts are up to \$16,500 to attend a 4-year college and up to \$14,250 to attend both community college and the option of continuing to a 4-year college.

Students from nearly 60 eligible partner high schools across 11 counties in Knox, Waldo, Lincoln, Hancock, Washington, Oxford, Somerset, Piscataquis, Penobscot, Franklin, and Sagadahoc are encouraged to apply.

Eligibility:

- Must be a graduating senior from a partner high school
- High School Grade Point Average (GPA): If planning to attend a 4-year college, high school GPA must be 3.0 or higher; If planning to attend a community college, high school GPA must be 2.2 or higher
- Have an Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) of \$15,000 or less as stated in the Student Aid Report of FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
- Be accepted and plan to attend full-time one of our Maine college partners in the Fall following your high school graduation
- Meet our ongoing semester-by-semester requirements

Deadlines:

April 15th for 4-year college applicants. July 1st for community college applicants.

STEP 6: Be sure to request your official GPA from your high school by using our request GPA feature of the application. You can type in the email address of your guidance counselor or equivalent high school contact and continue with the rest of the application. They will get the email alert to provide us your GPA online. We will then receive your GPA from your high school to fully process your application.
