- EFC \$15,000 or less
- Must be accepted to college prior to applying
- Fill out application on our website www.worthington scholars.org
- Full time enrollment at a partner community college
- \$1,500 per semester, renewable up to four semesters
- Additional funding available if student goes on to attend a 4-year partner college (or is enrolled in a 3-year program)

College Enrollment & Renewal Guidelines for Selected Students

- Create and maintain an account on Worthington Connect, our online portal
- Sign the *Worthington Scholarship Foundation Award Agreement*, agreeing to the terms of the scholarship
- Enroll & earn a minimum of 12 credits per semester
- Maintain a 2.0+ GPA throughout your college enrollment
