College Enrollment and Renewal Guidelines for Selected Students

- Sign the required forms
 - *Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) Release*, allowing us access to your academic and financial aid information
 - *Worthington Scholarship Foundation Award Letter*, acknowledging and agreeing to the terms of the scholarship
- Create and maintain an account on Worthington Connect, our online portal.
- Enroll for a minimum of 12 credits per semester
- Successfully earn 24 credits in an academic year
- Earn a cumulative 2.0+ GPA in first year of college
- Maintain a 2.5+ GPA second year of college and beyond
